## Planning for the Future: Strategies to Support our Children's Lifelong Needs

As a parent or family member of someone with a developmental disability, a lot of questions arise! Will they be able to work and sustain themselves? Can they get insurance? Should we gain guardianship? How do we support our loved one with PWS once we are gone? Do we need a special will? A trust? How do we do that?

PWSA of WI, Inc. is hosting a training to try and answer some of these many questions we all have as our loved one gets older. We have an attorney who will speak on wills and trusts; as well as other important legal documents to have. We have other speakers talking about guardianship, social security disability income (SSDI) and supplemental security income (SSI). We recognize that many of our members may not have children or loved ones near adult age, but it is so important to make plans before you reach the point of needing it!
